#### Member Benefits

- All current members will receive the museum publications The Semaphore and The Minnegazette, normally quarterly. The publications will have historic and current information about the plans, progress, and preservation activities of the Museum. Plus, be informed about the latest volunteer activities and be the first to know when new developments are on the Museum's horizon. You will have the opportunity to train to volunteer at all locations of the museum.
- Members who are active volunteers (15 hours or more per year) have access to the member's only web page; have the privilege to vote on board elections; may accept an appointment to a management position. All volunteers and Board members must be Museum members.
